TRANSPORTATION UPDATES –

Construction of Metis Trail, 4 lanes, from 64th Avenue NE to Stoney Trail should be completed by late 2010. The section from 96th Avenue NE to Stoney Trail will be completed later this fall with access from Country Hills Boulevard. Subject to acquisition of required land, construction of Metis Trail, 4 lanes, from 64th Avenue NE to 96th Avenue NE will begin early in 2010.

The Province anticipates the official opening of Stoney Trail from Centre Street to 17th Avenue SE on October 31st or November 1st, 2009. Please watch the Ward 3 website at www.ward3calgary.ca for updates on this opening.

Construction of the NE LRT line to Saddle Ridge Station is now underway. Premier Stelmach, Mayor Bronconnier and I attended the official sod turning ceremony in early September. The contract for construction of the new intersection at 64th Avenue NE, including a tunnel underneath for the LRT, should be awarded within the next few weeks

Repairs have been made to 36th Street NE to make it more passable until next year. I will continue to work with our Transportation Department to monitor the condition of 36th Street.
